Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars to them duly paid, have sold, and BY THESE PRESENTS do grant and convey to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all that tract or parcel of LAND, situated in the city of Rochester aforesaid, and described as follows Viz. Beginning at a point on the north side of Buffalo Street thirty two feet ten inches and a quarter (32 ft 10 1/4 in) westerly from the south east corner of Lot number Two hundred and twenty three 223 of the "Rochester, Barrol and Fitzhugh purchase" called the "Hundred acre tract" thence northerly at right angles with Buffalo Street one hundred and fifty three (153) feet to an alley, thence westerly parallel with Buffalo Street, eighty eight and one half (88 1/2) feet, thence southerly one hundred and fifty three (153) feet to Buffalo Street, and thence along the north line of said Buffalo Street, easterly eighty eight and one half (88 1/2) feet to the place of beginning, Being the same premises formerly known as the City Hotel Building, and laterly as the University of Rochester. Also the right of way in common with others through an alley in the rear of said premises running from Elizabeth Street easterly.

that the premises thus conveyed, in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, they will forever WARRANT AND DEFEND, against any person whomsoever, lawfully claiming the same, or any part thereof.
