

This Indenture, made this First day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three Between Azariah Boddy of the City of Rochester in the County of Monroe and State of New York and Ambia his wife of the first part, and The University of Rochester of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of **One Dollar**

of the second part,

do grant and convey to the said party of the second part, to them duly paid, have sold, and By these Presents
Laws and Assigns, all that tract or parcel of Land, situate in the
said City of Rochester and described as follows: Being part of lot number fifty eight
58 Second division Township number thirteen Seventh Range Beginning at a point in the
centre of Goodman Street six hundred and thirty seven (637) feet north from the
centre of Riley Street, thence westerly along the centre of said Goodman Street three
hundred and four (304) feet; thence westerly along the south line of a part of said
lot sold to James D. Royce by the party of the first part being in the centre of a street fifty (50) feet
wide to be laid out on said line eleven hundred and thirty one (1131) feet to the centre of the Street
or Avenue running north from the residence of A. Boddy the party of the first part; thence souther-
ly along the centre of said Street three hundred and ten (310) feet to a point eight hundred
and thirty seven (637) feet north of the centre of Riley Street thence easterly eleven hundred and
forty (1140) feet to the place of Beginning containing eight acres of land This conveyance is made
upon the following conditions viz that the said eight acres shall forever constitute the Site and grounds
of said University of Rochester and that the said University shall erect and forever maintain the buildings
required and that may be hereafter required for the purpose of said Institution so far as said
tract shall be adequate and convenient for the same Among which may be included residences
for the Instructors and officers of said University that the party of the second part may
lease to the New York Baptist Union for Ministerial Education a much of said eight acres
as may be necessary for the site of suitable buildings for said last named Institution such
lease to be made subject in all respects to the conditions of this Deed and in case said
eight acres shall cease to be occupied for the purpose aforesaid the same shall revert
to the Parties of the first part or their heirs Public Streets around any
part of said tract may be opened not more than one half the width of which to
be taken from the said hereby conveyed

With the Appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest therein of the said parties of the first part. And the said
Azariah Boddy does

do hereby covenant and agree, to and with the said party of the second part
and assigns, that the premises ^{thus} conveyed, in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part
and assigns, he will forever Warrant and Defend, against any person whomsoever, lawfully claiming the same, or any part thereof.
