

This Indenture, Made this First day of September in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and fifty three Between Azariah Boardy of the City of
 Rochester in the county of Monroe and State of New York and
 of the first part, and
 The University of Rochester of the same place

Witnesseth, That the party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Sixteen thousand Seven
 hundred and Thirty Dollars ^{of the second part,} when duly paid, has sold, and By these Presents
 do grant and convey to the said party of the second part its successors and assigns, all that tract or parcel of Land, situate in the
 said city of Rochester and described as follows: Being a part of lot
 number fifty Eight 58, second Division Township number Thirteen
 (13) seventh range Beginning at a point in the centre of Riley Street
 and in the centre of the Street running North from the residence
 of A Boardy the party of the first part, then northerly in the centre
 of said Street Six hundred and thirty seven (637) feet thence Eastward
 parallel with Riley Street eleven hundred and forty (1140) feet to
 the centre of Goodman Street, thence southerly along the centre
 of said Goodman Street Six hundred and thirty seven (637) feet
 to the centre of Riley Street thence westerly along the centre of Riley
 Street Eleven hundred and fifty seven (1157) feet to the head of Beginning
 containing Sixteen acres and Sixty nine hundredths of an acre 16 690
 of Land.
