

These supplementary conditions purpose is to address specific campus issues. The supplementary conditions are created to work in association with the Division 1 specifications. An item referenced in this section supersedes that particular item in the Division 1 section.

A. Section 015000 or 015001:

1. 3.3.B. Parking
  - a. The University will make parking available, at no cost, to the Contractor's personnel or work vehicles at the Memorial Art Gallery (MAG) parking lot. Contractor to gain approval and location for parking from the Memorial Art Gallery Manager of Facilities & Exhibitions.
2. 3.4.D. Security Enclosure, Lock Up & Escort:
  - a. The Memorial Art Gallery (MAG) Facilities & Exhibition Staff will provide locks for temporary enclosures or storage areas. The contractor will not be issued keys. The Memorial Art Gallery Facilities & Exhibition Staff will lock and unlock areas as needed. Contractor is responsible to coordinate access with the Memorial Art Gallery Facilities & Exhibition Staff as required.
  - b. Contractor shall be escorted throughout spaces when the gallery is closed. Escort to be provided by MAG personal as determined by the MAG Facilities & Exhibition Office.
  - c. Contractor may need to be escorted throughout spaces when the gallery is open. Determination if escort is required to be decided by the MAG Facilities & Exhibition Office.
3. 3.4.C.2 Smoking on the Memorial Art Gallery Campus
  - a. Smoking or tobacco use, including cigarettes, cigarillos, cigars, pipes, hookahs, clove cigarette, pipe tobacco, snuff, smokeless, oral or spit tobacco and the use of electronic cigarettes is prohibited at all times on University property, including in all of its buildings, residence halls and their grounds, clinics, laboratories, classrooms, private offices, plazas, vestibules and loading docks.
  - b. Designated areas have been identified and can be provided upon request.
